The people who are doing this in the summer are the very reason the gates were closed last winter. These trespassers are ruining your winter access.

On Saturday, June 27 at 4:30pm, I, along with some friends were fixing one of barriers when two trespassing quads came along. A man and child were on one quad and a women and child were on the other. I stopped them and told them they were trespassing. Not only did they say they "did not care", there was a blatant disregard for the no trespassing signs. Furthermore, while I was photographing them for evidence, the quad driven by the man (child in tow) assaulted me. The woman driving the other quad verbally threatened one of the women that were there with me. As a result, the Kittitas County Sheriffs Office was called and the case, with photos, was turned over to them. They are actively looking for the people in the photos and intend on charging them. Your help in identifying these people is greatly appreciated. The quads were both new looking Suzukis, one mostly white and the other yellow. Neither quad had stickers at that time. The board was notified and sent photos as well. I am also posting the photos in the lodge.

If you have any information, please contact a board member or myself. The information will be sent on to the Sheriff's office.

For those of you who do not know, the sheriff said that in this county criminal trespass is an automatic Kittitas County Court appearance with a minimum \$200 fine.
